	Use a pet carrier that is secure, well ventilated and meets the IATA Live Animal regulations.		
	Ventilation openings must be a maximum of 25mm x 25mm for dogs and 19mm x 19mm for cats.		
	Food and water containers must be securely attached within the carrier and refillable from the outside.		
	Provide enough food as required and include feeding instruction (if required) securely fixed to the outside of the carrier.		
	Provide sufficient absorbent material inside the carr	rier.
